

Increasing Community Access to Testing (ICATT) Pharmacy Program

Background

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services' (HHS) Increasing Community Access to Testing (ICATT) Program partners with pharmacies nationwide to provide no-cost testing with a focus on vulnerable communities.

While the ICATT mission focuses on maximizing testing for vulnerable communities, all testing sites are open to any member of the public. Since April 2020, ICATT has sponsored 14.8 million tests and more than 8,000 pharmacy sites have performed no-cost testing.

ICATT Pharmacy Partners manage COVID-19 testing

- The HHS ICATT Team selects pharmacy testing sites, monitors pharmacy testing, and engages states to optimize testing activities.
- ICATT pharmacy partners schedule appointments, register patients for testing, collect patient samples, process tests, and report results to individuals and public health entities.

- 1) Over the counter tests are available but not funded by the federal government
- 2) Walgreens PCR testing is billed to private insurance or the HRSA uninsured program
- 3) eTN Point of Care (POC) testing projected for September 2021
- 4) Adding new pharmacy sites in August and September 2021
- 5) Expanding to new states August and September 2021
- 6) Adding (POC) testing August and September of 2021
- 7) CVS locations are community testing sites; testing in CVS pharmacies is not currently funded by the federal government. CVS bills private insurance and the HRSA uninsured program for tests performed. HHS will fund testing in some CVS pharmacy locations in August and September in states where CVS testing is currently unavailable; these sites will be identified in monthly reports to states and posted to Google Maps, Castlight, CVS website, and the ICATT website.
